> Cargo Timisoara is a performance that takes place in a truck specially arranged for the public. A co-production with key actors of the European documentary theater scene, Rimini Protokoll, Cargo Berlin - Timişoara is a road performance in a truck, a sitespecific performance in which the city of Timișoara becomes the stage, a road movie through the reverse side of a globalized economy. Thus, the truck becomes an observer, a binocular, a microscope.

Who am I going with?

As in most of the performances of the Basca Theatre, I will go both with those who are familiar with the style of social theater, which presents often uncomfortable subjects above the artistic dimension, and with those who have never been to the theater before. Open to all, for a world with broader views. From the binoculars of a truck, on the highway of life.

What do I get from this experience?

After a road movie, I can only be left with a different view of the lives of people we often know too little about. As a viewer, you'll be transported for two hours between gas stations, industrial loading ramps and other globalization hotspots, synchronized live with a score composed for the landscape outside the window. Along the way, truck driver biographies will be broadcast to the audience from the truck.

> The Euroregional Theatre Festival of Timisoara, TESZT, is one of the most important projects of the Hungarian State Theatre "Csiky Gergely " and will reach its fourteenth edition in 2023. The selection brings together contemporary, alternative, physical theater and contemporary dance performances that are invited to Romania for the first time, and all of them are simultaneously translated into Romanian, Hungarian and English. The audience has the opportunity to meet the artists during post-show discussions. The ExTES7T section is an extension dedicated to independent theater companies from Timisoara. The 2023 edition also includes the Fluid Views section, focusing on LGBTQIA+ community issues, co-curated with the Identity organization, as well as two concerts and two theater-

themed exhibitions. Education. Outdoor performances are free to the public. The foreign troupes in the 2023 main selection come from Hungary, Serbia, Greece, Italy, Germany, Slovenia, Belgium, Poland, Bulgaria.

> Trans Lucid is a performance that explores significant aspects of the lives of trans people in Romania, focusing on the many changes they have experienced. Trans Lucid uses personal stories that center on moments representative of the history of the trans community. Knowing our history is liberating. It takes us out of the invisibility that criminal codes, abusive policies, and the media have constantly pushed us into. Knowing our history is liberating. We claim it, we know it, we tell it, we stage it, we dance it, we use our bodies to represent it, we change it. Creating our history is even

more liberating. TransLucid imagines a future where we write our own narratives and build the world we want and need.

Who am I going with?

I go with those who understand or want to understand the importance of the inclusive dimension of trans people from different cultural spaces around the world.

What do I get from this experience?

I'll leave with the perspective of an issue that I may not have understood before, I leave with an exercise in empathy, I leave with a bittersweet feeling. Sweet because Trans Lucid puts a lot of vulnerability on the table, with a smile, bitter because the hope of a utopian future for trans people still remains a figment of the imagination.

"Lucky Dust" starts from a series of writings and performances by Portuguese choreographer Vera Mantero, dating from the second part of the 1980s and the 1990s, as well as from texts written during the process of working on the performance in 2022 and 2023, and generated two solos performed by Mădălina Dan and Vera Mantero.

The Retracing Bartók Project is a multidisciplinary cultural archaeology project, conceived as a celebration of the extraordinary diversity and richness of traditional Romanian music, while at the same time being an artistic reflection on the transformation of folk song in contemporary culture and a reconstruction of Béla Bartók's story in Romania and his love for music from this part of the world.

Beginning in 1907, Béla Bartók undertook a series of research trips to Transylvania and Banat, recording and documenting the largest collection of Romanian folk songs to date - over 1,300 instrumental and vocal songs. Bartók thus laid the foundations of modern ethno-musicology. Developed over several years since 2018, Retracing Bartók aims to identify and bring together musicians, ethnographers, museographers, anthropologists, visual artists, cultural operators and institutions in a participatory process open to the exploitation of cultural heritage through contemporary multidisciplinary forms of knowledge, facilitation and strengthening of cultural production mechanisms in

order to prepare the local scene for the year 2023.

Who am I going with?

I will go with all those interested in the history of this cultural space.

What do I get from this experience?

I can leave with a sense of belonging to a special cultural space, steeped in history and a better understanding of the concept of cultural archaeology. A glimpse into the extraordinary diversity and richness of traditional Romanian music, but also into how folk song has been transformed in contemporary culture.

Songs collected more than 100 years ago by Bela Bartok in Banat and Transylvania will be reinterpreted in a contemporary key.

Baroque Watermusic consists of a series of three lecture concerts held at the Faculty of Music and Theatre in Timisoara, as well as five concerts of early music performed on a baroquestyle boat that will sail on the Bega. The three concertlessons will present period instruments, their specific playing techniques, as well as the repertoire of early music, while the five concerts on the Bega will present to the public an original repertoire from the Renaissance and Baroque, vocal-instrumental, performed on period instruments and with period costumes. The instruments presented in this project are: lute, theorbo, viola da gamba, barogue flute, baroque violins, harpsichord. The instrumentalists are professional musicians from Cluj, Timisoara and Budapest, together with soprano Narcisa Brumar, from the Romanian National Opera Timisoara, first soloist of this institution.

Launmomentdat in the Park Festival is a special occasion that brings the community together to celebrate music through a special programme of concerts and activities.
